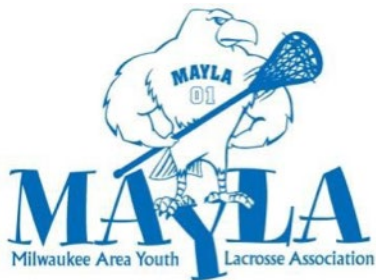

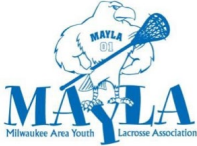

Boys 3/4 - \$150 check (collected in spring) as deposit to rent equipment from FLC: helmet, shoulder pads, gloves, and stick to be returned to the club at the end of the season (Player responsible for elbow pads, mouth guard, and cup)

Girls 3/4 - FLC will provide goggles and stick to be returned to the club at the end of the season (Player responsible for mouth guard)

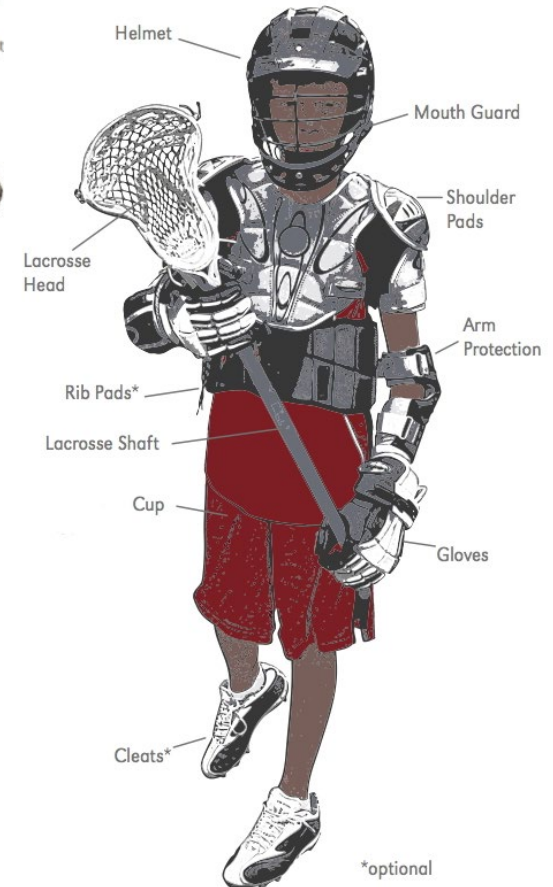

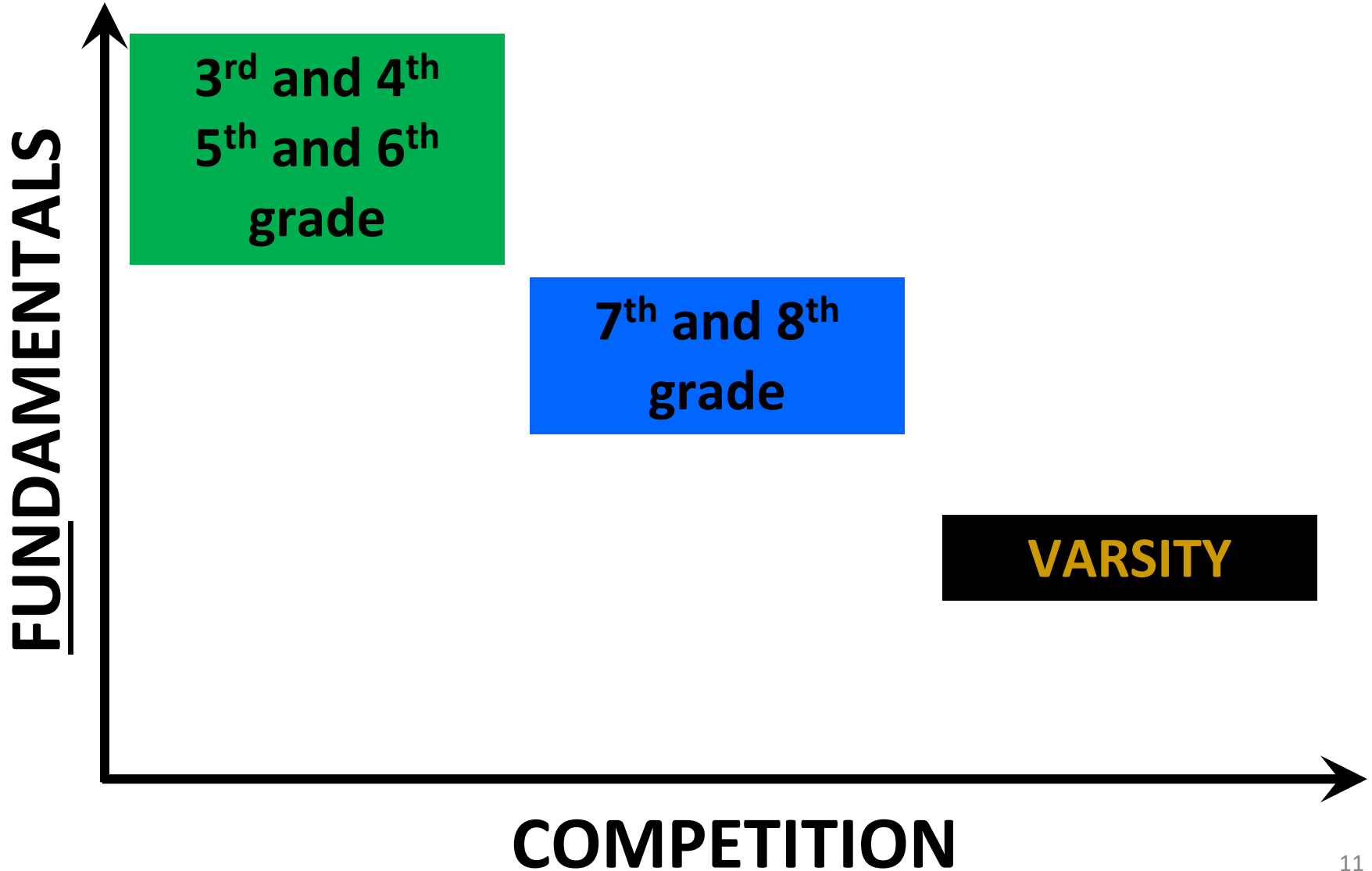

# Code of Conduct
