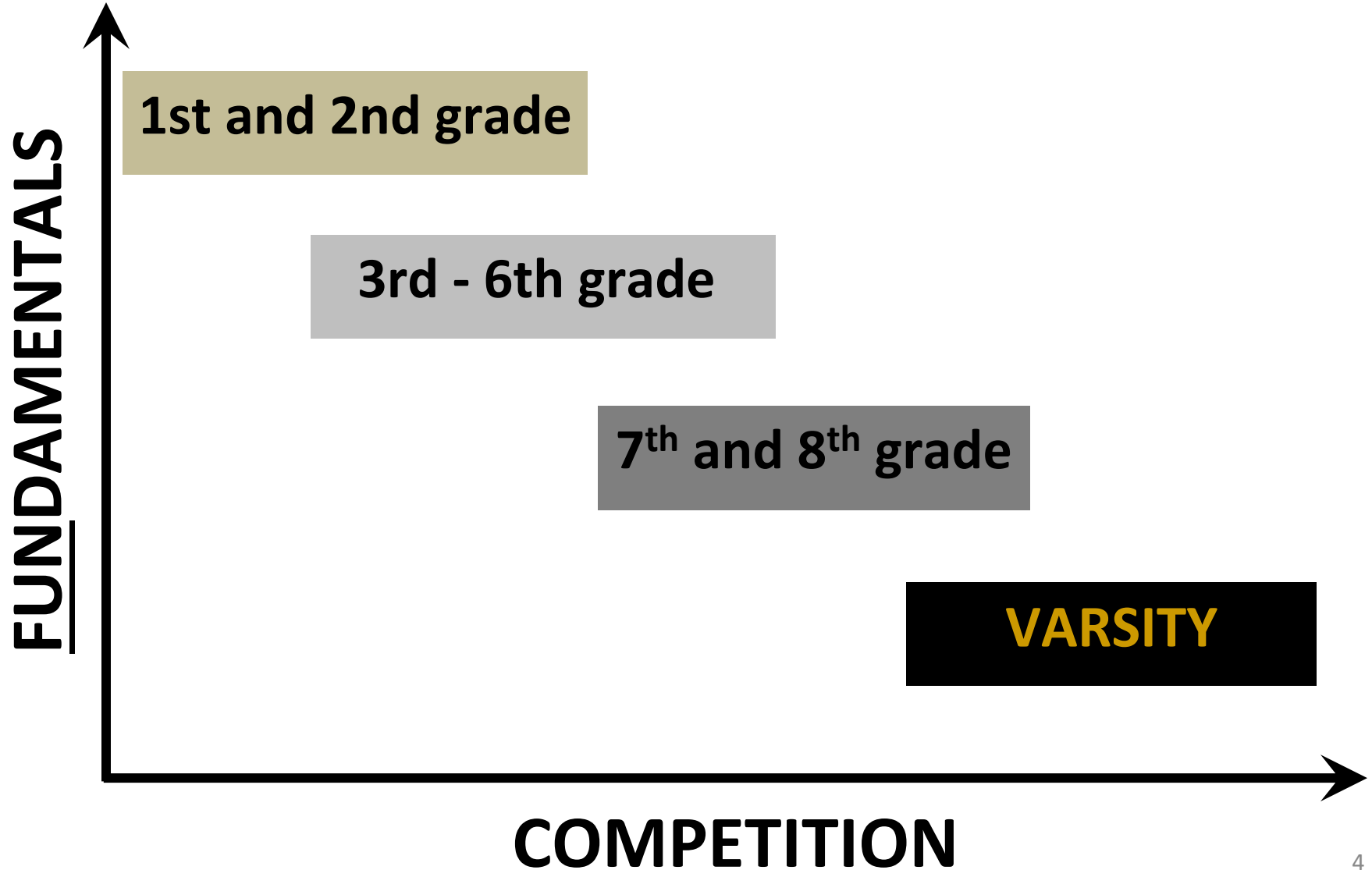

What Equipment and Gear is Needed ?

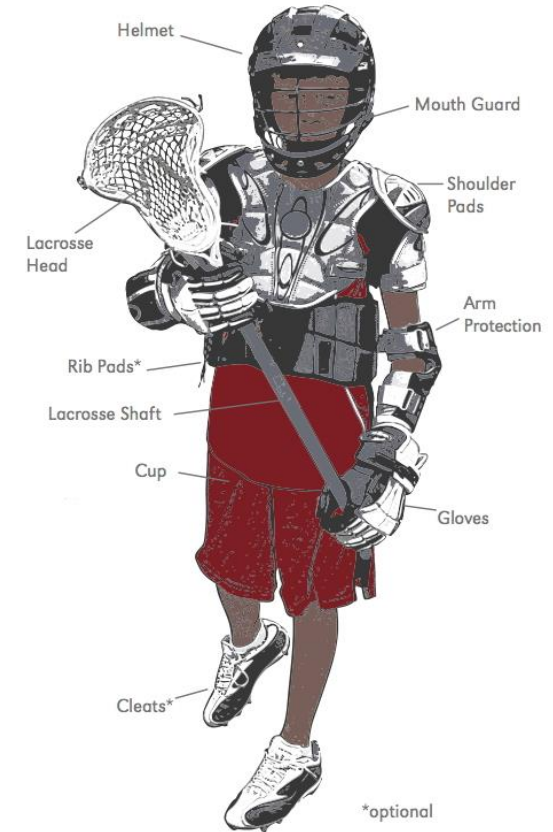
• BOYS
