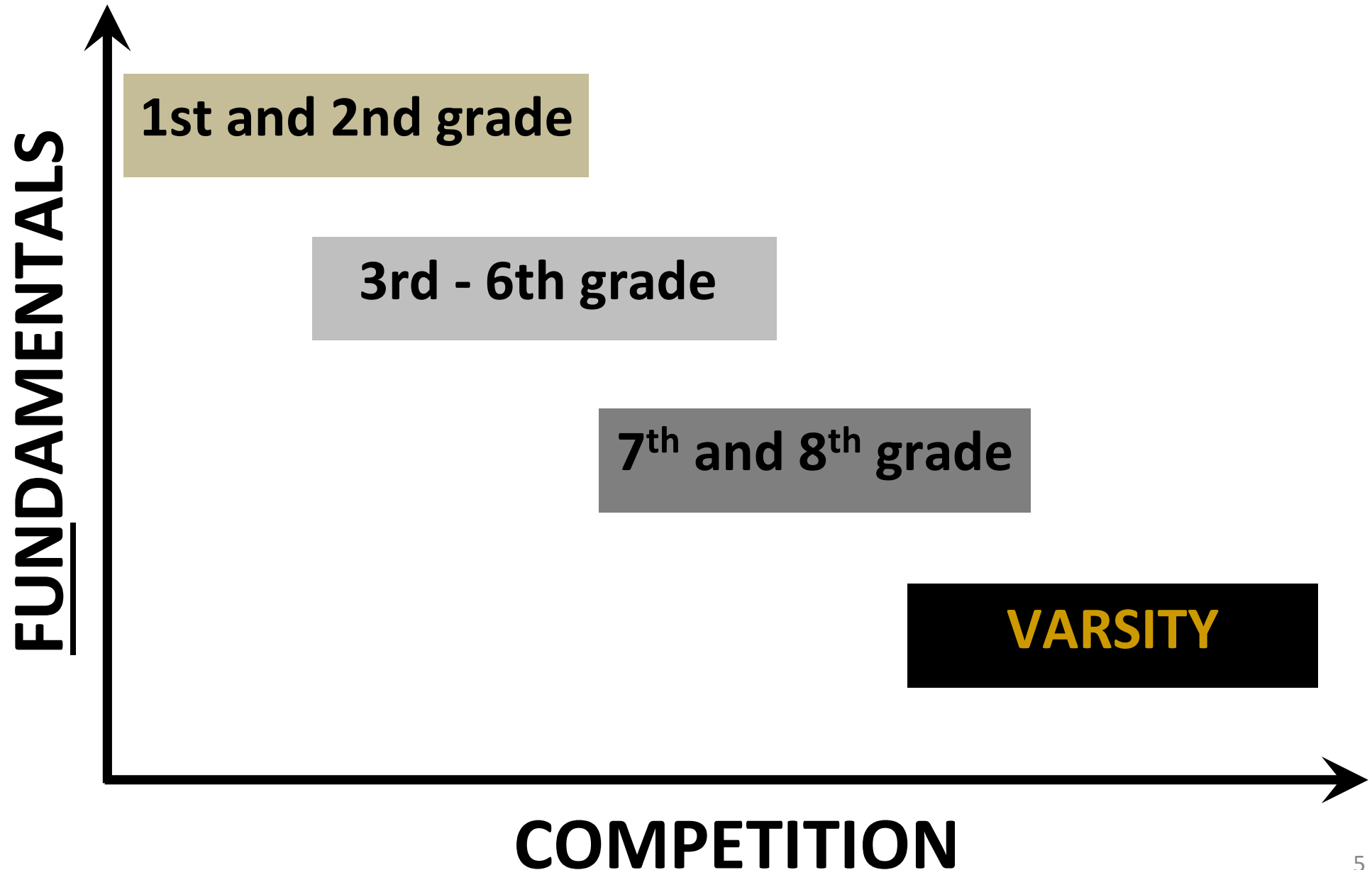

- Play all positions
- Learn the game

•U12 / U14

- Gradual transition from U12 to U14
- Team focuses on competitiveness
- Position play – tilts towards specialized
- Playing time based on skill

Team Managers

- Each team will have a Team Manager
- Team Manager duties include:
 - Schedule games
 - Load team schedule into Team Snap
 - Set-up game day volunteers
 - Plan end of season team party
 - Communication liaison between coaching staff and families

BOYS & GIRLS U8 (Grades 1/2)

Boys - FLC will provide pinny, helmet, shoulder pads, gloves. *Player responsible for elbow pads, mouth guard, and cup.*

Players return all club gear and keep their uniform.

Girls - FLC will provide pinny, goggles, and stick. *Player responsible for mouth guard.*

BOYS & GIRLS U10 (3/4)

Boys - FLC will provide pinny, helmet, shoulder pads, gloves. Player responsible for elbow pads, mouth guard, and cup.

Players return all club gear and keep their uniform.

Approximately \$120

Girls - FLC will provide pinny, goggles, and stick. Player responsible for mouth guard.

BOYS & GIRLS U14 (5/6 and 7/8)

All 5/6 and 7/8 players are responsible for their equipment. Cost is dependent on selection of purchased or rented equipment.

What Equipment and Gear is Needed ?

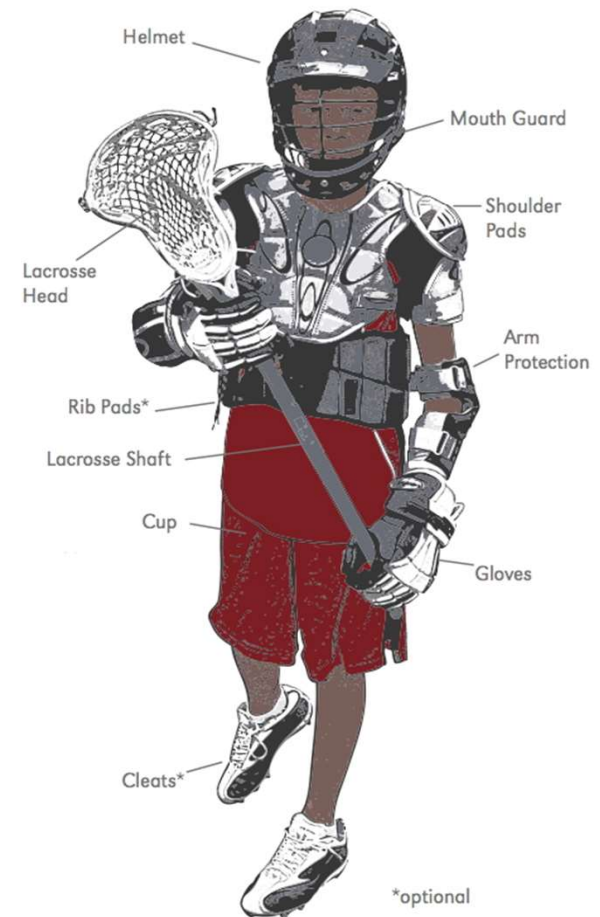
• BOYS

- Goggles – **MUST be SEI certified**
- Mouth guard (NOT white or clear)

Code of Conduct
